



## Discipleship Year Outline 2019/2020

### Ministry

- 3 days a week (Mon, Wed- Fri) in one or two ministry areas at church, such as: Youth, Worship, Children, Families, Seniors, Media and Communications, The Hub (café space), Creative
- Serving on a Sunday with opportunities to lead, speak, serve and minister across different services.
- Possible wider ministry opportunities including short term mission trips or training conferences.

### Discipleship and Leadership Formation

- One day a week (Tuesdays) at the New Wine Training Centre where you'll be equipped, empowered and encouraged to grow as a disciple of Jesus.
- A mission trip opportunity and serving on team at New Wine in the summer (July 2020).
- Access to St Paul's staff development, team building and mentoring.
- Support as you work out your own rhythm of spiritual disciplines throughout the year.
- 2 weekends away with the New Wine Discipleship Year for training and input.

### Example timetable

You will have 3 days of work in one or two areas of ministry, a flexible work-lite day, a day off and Sunday service ministry. You will be working on Wednesdays when staff gather, and other days will be fixed dependent on your choice of ministry area.

<b>Monday</b>	Ministry Area work, eg helping in Toddlers
<b>Tuesday</b>	Discipleship Year Course
<b>Wednesday</b>	Mentoring/training in Ministry Area work incl staff gatherings
<b>Thursday</b>	Ministry area work, eg helping with youth
<b>Friday</b>	Work-lite Day
<b>Saturday</b>	Day Off
<b>Sunday</b>	Ministry: 2 Church services (usually 10am and 6pm)

## **Application Process**

The Discipleship Year is on offer to everyone 18-24 years old. Please complete the DY online application form, found here: [www.new-wine.org/mission-areas/discipleship-year](http://www.new-wine.org/mission-areas/discipleship-year). The application deadline is: Friday 21 June 2019, but applications will be considered as they are submitted, so apply as early as possible. When applying, select the New Wine Training Centre as West London (Ealing).

You will then have an interview with Martin Wainwright, Sally Thomas and one other member of the staff team, depending on your chosen area of ministry.

## **Cost**

There is no cost for this gap year programme. St Paul's will pay the whole Discipleship Year cost, this includes the church and student fees. We will also cover any of your expenses incurred on church activities. The only cost to you will be raising a contribution to the DY mission trip.

## **Timeline**

The course will begin early September and finish the following August after New Wine.
