

Update from Hazel Maunsell

Hazel Maunsell – retirement

Recently we received news that Hazel is now taking well-deserved retirement from her work with Crosslinks. She is currently living in a community in Lingfield, surrounded by fellow Christians. Please pray for her in this new chapter.

Previously trained and working as a teacher, Hazel first arrived in Ethiopia in 1973. She went with Crosslinks (then called the Bible Churchmen's Missionary Society or BCMS), an international mission society with its roots in the Bible. Hazel married Colin Maunsell in England in 1981, together they served with Crosslinks in Portugal for 9 years doing Church and Portuguese Christian literature work. Colin and Hazel returned together to Ethiopia in 1991, shortly after the fall of the Communist regime. Together they developed a ministry of Bible teaching and producing Christian materials in Amharic. Colin died in Ethiopia in 2005. In more recent years Hazel has continued to write for the Pillar book series. Among recently published titles are books on the Lord's Prayer, the Sermon on the Mount, and the Resurrection of Christ.
